PAYMENT OPTIONS

Credit card — Credit cards are accepted for one-payment plan and two-payment plan options as well as tuition deposit and registration fee.

Option A — One-Payment Plan

Submit one payment for total charges, due July 1, 2018.

Option B — Two-Payment Plan

Tuition is paid in two installments: 70 percent of the tuition is due on July 1, 2018; the remaining 30 percent is due on December 1, 2018.

ASSESSMENTS

- A \$35 late fee and interest at 18% APR based on the balance of the account will be charged monthly if your payment is not received by the 10th day after payment is due.
- A \$35 fee will be assessed for each returned check.
- Any change in payment option or method must be made in writing.
